


Process for becoming a Certified Lay Speaker

A certified lay speaker is a certified lay servant whose call has been affirmed by the Michigan conference committee on lay servant ministries to serve the church in pulpit supply in accordance and compliance with the United Methodist Discipline ¶341.1.





Steps to Become a Certified Lay Speaker (CLS) Michigan Conference of The UMC | 2019

- 1. Be currently certified as a lay servant.
- 2. Obtain written recommendation from the pastor and the church council or charge conference of the local church in which you hold membership.
- 3. Complete a track of study including one course from each of the following subject categories:
 - a. The BASIC Course for Lay Servant Ministries. CANNOT BE TAKEN ON-LINE
 - b. Leading worship: Leading Worship, Taylor Burton-Edwards or Your Ministry of Leading Worship 101 (online).
 - c. Leading prayer: Leading in Prayer, Mary O. Benedict or Leading Public Prayer (online).
 - d. Discovering Spiritual Gifts: Discover Your Spiritual Gifts, William J. Carter or Rediscovering Our Spiritual Gifts (online).
 - e. Preaching: Called to Preach, Dawn Chesser. CANNOT BE TAKEN ON-LINE
 - f. United Methodist Heritage: Living Our United Methodist Beliefs, George Hovaness Donigian or Living Our United Methodist Beliefs (online).
 - g. United Methodist Polity: Life Together in the United Methodist Connection, Beth Galbreath or Life Together in the United Methodist Connection (online).
 - h. Additional classes in these categories as they are available from Discipleship Resources.
 - NO MORE THAN HALF OF THESE CLASSES MAY BE TAKEN ON-LINE
- 4. Interview with and obtain recommendation from the district committee on lay servant ministries, to be submitted to the conference committee on lay servant ministries, for approval and certification.
- 5. Submit a written copy of a sermon along with audio/video of the delivery. Include three sermon evaluations. Include your current charge conference annual report.



To maintain status as a Michigan Conference Certified Lay Speaker, you must:

- 1. Submit an annual report and renewal application to the charge conference or church council and to the district committee on lay servant ministries, giving evidence of satisfactory performance as a certified lay speaker.
- 2. Obtain recommendation for continued recognition as a certified lay speaker from the pastor and the church council or charge conference of the local church or other United Methodist ministry in which you hold membership.
- 3. Complete at least one lay servant ministries advanced course in the last three years.
- 4. In the last three years, have interviewed with and obtained recommendation for renewal as a certified lay speaker from the district committee on lay servant ministries, and the approval of the conference committee on lay servant ministries, for recertification.
