The Mission of the Central Bay District is to resource and enable the local church to Make Disciples of Jesus Christ for the Transformation of the World.

The district organizational structure utilized in the past was designed for a different cultural context. In the last century, change was much more predictable and occurred at a slower pace. Today, we live in a culture of rapid and unpredictable change. The district needs an organizational structure that is flexible, accountable, and adaptable.

To enable this, the Leadership Team (LT) will be reduced of those chairing the various district ministries, freeing them to focus on their ministry areas. The LT will consist of up to nine persons who have demonstrated the spiritual gifts of leadership and include the District Superintendent, District Lay Leader, and District Executive Administrator. The Assistant Administrator and the Treasurer shall participate as ex-officio members with voice but no vote.

The primary duty of the LT will be to keep the district focused on its mission to resource and enable the local church to live into and out of its mission for the making of disciples of Jesus. This will be expressed in its responsibility to provide accountability for the leadership of the district ministries, to oversee any and all fiduciary responsibilities of the district, to review and disperse grants, for the purpose of enabling the local church to live into its mission, and loans, to assist in needed capital improvements of the local church.
